	Roof gutters	Clean out leaves and debris frequently to ensure
	Nooi gutters	water flows freely and does not accumulate.
	Black corrugated pipes for	Grooves in plastic pipes can hold enough water to
	downspout drainage	breed mosquitoes. Treat with a larvicide.
	Buckets, watering cans, drinking glasses, plastic cups, bottle caps or any trash that can hold water	Store indoors or turn over. If trash, recycle or throw away.
	Cans and containers	Throw away, store indoors, turn upside down, drill
		holes in the bottom, or empty after rain showers.
	Old tires	Recycle or store where they won't collect rainwater.
		For playground use, drill water drainage holes. Call
		your municipality or city for recycling information.
	Bird baths	Change the water or flush out and clean with a
		garden hose at least once a week.
	Landscape ponds	Stock with fish (fish eat mosquito larvae), filter/
		aerate the water with a recirculation pump or treat
	Potted plants with saucers	with a larvicide as needed.
		Empty saucers or flush out with garden hose once a week.
	Dripping outdoor faucets and	If water puddles, repair faucet. Place rocks under
	window air conditioners	window air conditioner to ensure water runoff.
	willdow all colluitioners	If using, run pump/filter and add pool chemicals on a
	Swimming pools	regular basis. If unused or abandoned, treat water
		with larvicide once per month. Make attempt to close
		the pool with a secure cover.
		Drain water weekly with a pump or treat water
	Swimming pool covers	monthly with a larvicide.
	Children's toys	Store indoors or in a manner that prevents water
		accumulation. Note that some toys have inner
		compartments that can hold water.
	Tarps on woodpiles and garden	Empty water that collects in folds and sagging
	equipment	areas. Tighten or straighten so water runs off.
	Wheelbarrows	Turn over when not in use.
		Turn over when not in use.
	Under decks, porches or	Fill in depressions where water can collect. Remove
	outbuildings	any container that can collect water.
	Garbage cans, recycle bins,	Keep covered or drill drainage holes in bottom.
	other barrels	Place lids on garbage cans. Store bins and barrels to
		allow water runoff.
	Canoes, boats	Cover with a tight-fitting tarp or store upside down.
