US Airways Selects Pittsburgh for its Combined Flight Operations Control Center

In February 2007, US Airways selected a site at Pittsburgh International Airport for its new \$25 million, 60,000 square-foot flight operations control center. Currently, US Airways operates an operations center in Pittsburgh (for US Airways) and Phoenix (for America West).

The new flight operations control center will have workspace for more than 600 professional employees who plan, track and handle US Airways' flights. The airline's Flight Dispatch, Maintenance Operations Control, Crew Scheduling, System Customer Service, Operations Engineering Groups along with administrative support will be located at the new facility.

The new US Airways -- the product of a merger between America West and US Airways in September 2005 -- is a member of the Star Alliance network, which offers our customers 16,000 daily flights to 855 destinations in 155 countries worldwide.
