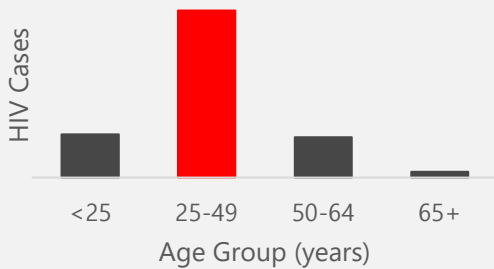

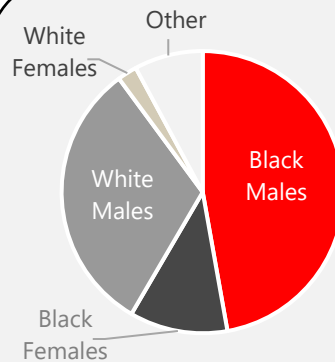
New HIV cases diagnosed with AIDS within 90 days

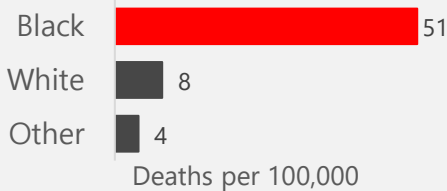
Approximate number of people living with HIV



Most new HIV cases were among persons 25-49 years old

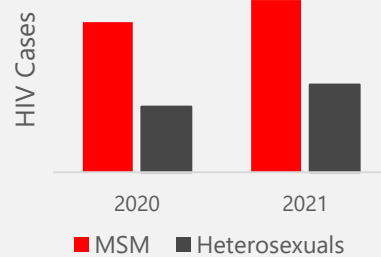


Black residents accounted for 58% of new HIV cases, while Black males alone accounted for 47% of cases



The 10-year HIV/AIDS mortality rate was 6x higher among Black residents compared to White residents

New HIV cases increased 15% in men who have sex with men and 33% in those with heterosexual contact since 2020
