Health Department Provides Data on Recent COVID-19 Cases

PITTSBURGH – The Allegheny County Health Department is providing the following data on recent cases of COVID-19.

Between May 21 and June 3, Health Department staff started investigations on 253 new cases of COVID-19.

Of these:

- 29 (12%) are healthcare workers
- 11 (4%) are employees at long-term care facilities. These employees are also counted in the healthcare worker data
- 66 (26%) are residents in long-term care facilities
- 158 people (62%) are neither healthcare workers nor residents of long-term care facilities
- 123 of 253 (49%) are linked to another known case. 85 are linked to a known cluster of cases. 38 are linked to another known individual case
- Of the 85 linked to known clusters,

58 are linked to clusters at long-term care facilities

21 are linked to workplaces other than long-term care facilities

6 are linked to other sources

 Of 158 cases that are not healthcare workers or in long-term care centers, 36% are linked to another known individual or cluster.

Age break downs:

For the 253 cases:

Age 0-9: 14 cases (5.5%) Age 10-19: 14 cases (5.5%) 20-29: 39 cases (15%) 30-39: 43 cases (17%) 40-49: 25 cases (10%) 50-59: 32 cases (13%) 60-69: 31 cases (12%) 70+: 55 cases (22%) For the 29 healthcare workers:

No cases in HCWs <age 20 20-29: 10 cases (34.5%) 30-39: 9 cases (31%) 40-49: 3 cases (10%) 50-59: 4 cases (14%) 60-69: 3 cases (10%) No cases in HWCs > age 70
