Single-Lane Closure on Talbot Avenue in Rankin to Begin November 15

PITTSBURGH – The Department of Public Works announced today that part of the right southbound lane on Talbot Avenue near Kenmawr Avenue/Braddock Avenue in Rankin Borough will close at 9 a.m. on Monday, November 15, 2021. The lane closure, which is expected to last at least two weeks, is required to repair a steel beam underneath a ramp.

Traffic will be maintained in both directions throughout the project. All southbound traffic will be required to use the left lane at the work zone.

The steel beam that will be repaired was found to be corroded during a routine inspection in October. To ensure safety, Public Works then implemented a vehicle weight limit on the ramp. After the beam is repaired, that weight limit will be removed.

The \$25,500 emergency project will be done by Pugliano Construction Co., Inc., of Pittsburgh.
