Six Bills, Three Appointments Submitted to Council for Its August 23 Meeting

PITTSBURGH – County Executive Rich Fitzgerald submitted six bills to County Council for its referral or consideration at its upcoming August 23 meeting:

- Ordinance ratifying amendments to Article XXI, Air Pollution Control, related to permit hearing advertising notice and permit petition requirements; the revisions address EPA's new permit petition requirements, consolidation of sections that incorporate PA DEP noticing requirements, and several nomenclature changes; a public comment period was held on the proposed revision, as was a public hearing before the amendments were voted on and approved by the Board of Health
- Ordinance ratifying amendments to Article XXI, Air Pollution control, to remove provisions related to the Risk Management Program after its delegated authority, implementation and enforcement authority was returned to the EPA; a public comment period was held on the proposed revision, as was a public hearing before the amendments were voted and approved by the Board of Health
- Ordinance approving the sale of the county's interest in a parcel of property on Potomac Street in Oakmont to an adjacent buyer who will improve the property by expanding the side yard of her adjacent personal residence; the professional appraisal of the property was set at a fair market value of \$1,000; Oakmont Borough and Riverview School District have already enacted resolutions agreeing to see their respective one-third interests in the property
- Ordinance authorizing the Western Pennsylvania Police Athletic League to continue to use a structure on Monroeville Trestle Road in the county's Boyce Park to conduct boxing activities; the authorization would continue through September 30, 2025
- Ordinance authorizing South Park Boxing, Inc. to continue to use a structure on Hundred Acres Drive in the county's South Park to conduct boxing activities; the authorization would continue through September 30, 2025
- Ordinance creating a separate county department as of January 1, 2023 to be known as the Department of Sustainability; the duties, functions and responsibilities of the department are outlined in the ordinance but the department would, generally, be charged with establishing a comprehensive approach to integrate and promote environmentally sound practices and sustainable solutions within county government
