PRESIDENT CATENA: Is there any public comment this evening on agenda items?

MR. BARKER: We have none.

PRESIDENT CATENA: Approval of minutes?

PRESIDENT CATENA: Presentation of appointments. 11596-20.

MR. BARKER: Approving the re-appointment of Ed Eichenlaub to the Council of Friends for South Park for a term to expire on September 8, 2022 sponsored by Council Member Duerr.

to the Eminent Domain Code sponsored by the Chief Executive.

BARKER: An ordinance authorizing the County of Allegheny in conjunction with the Department of Public Works and the Law Department to convey by special warranty deed two parcels of land described as 12,989 square feet of land being all of Block and Lot Number 375-C-185 and 13,986 square feet of land being all of Block and Lot Number 375-C-191, both parcels of land being situate in the Borough of North Braddock, Allegheny County, to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania acting through its Department of Transportation sponsored by the Chief Executive.

MR. PALMIERE: I just wanted to mention I was just informed that out of 536 nursing schools, CCAC was just ranked number 10, and I just wanted to congratulate Dr. Bullock and his staff. It's a wonderful achievement. Thank you, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT CATENA: Thank you. Anyone else this evening? Councilman Palmosina?

MR. PALMOSINA: Thank you, Mr. President. I just want to touch base on 9/6 of last week on Sunday we had a cleanup in our neighborhood District 12 county council and District 2 city council sponsored by Theresa Kail-Smith and the Allegheny Fayette Central Labor Council President Darrin Kelly along with Craig Romanovich, a host of the unions, and the job was to clean up the war memorial at the corner of Obie and Steuben Street along with neighborhood residents and some veterans that came out. We cleaned the monument. We weeded it. We took down some bushes. We mulched it, and it was my honor - it was one of the greatest things in the last couple months with everything going on that I had a chance to participate in. Theresa Kail-Smith set it all up.

Along with Craig Romanovich we had the carpenters, SCIU Electrical, 1058 Steamfitters, Senator Iovino, Congressman Lamb, Alice Creager from the mail carriers, State Representative Dan Deasy, our own county councilman Tom Duerr. Thanks for being there, Tom. Steamfitters, SCIU, if I forgot anybody - but the most touching thing on that was we had a veteran that came out from my neighborhood that I have known for about 30 years. Al Burokowski.

Al lost his wife several years ago, and it was the first time I got a chance to see him since she passed away. So I wanted to give him our deepest sympathy

from our council to the Burokowski family, but Al was also having and battling some of his own health issues. He has several health issues that are related to Agent Orange, and I just think what a day with the laborers and the veterans and I think this country needs to realize how many folks have gone through a lot to get us where we're at with Labor and the veterans to live in this great country. That being said, I just want to reach out to everybody out there and say happy Labor Day and thank you, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT CATENA: Thank you. We'll go on to new business ordinances and resolutions. 11599-20.

MR. BARKER: An ordinance amending the Allegheny County Code of Ordinances Division 2 entitled "County Government Operations," Chapter 215, entitled "Boards, Commissions and Committees," Article V, entitled "Human Relations Commission," in order to clarify the applicability of existing Countywide nondiscrimination requirements in the context of discrimination based upon hairstyles sponsored by Council Members Bennett, Prizio, and Hallam.

PRESIDENT CATENA: That will go to government reform. 11600-20.

MR. BARKER: An ordinance of the County of Allegheny, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania amending the Administrative Code of Allegheny County, Article 1009, entitled "Personnel Policies," in order to establish a paid holiday structure for all County employees sponsored by Council Members Bennet and Hallam.

PRESIDENT CATENA: That will go to government reform. 11601-20.

MR. BARKER: An ordinance amending the definition of rental vehicle set forth in the Allegheny County Code of Ordinances, Division 1, the Allegheny County Administrative Code, Article 808.B entitled "Rental Vehicle Taxation," sponsored by the Chief Executive.

PRESIDENT CATENA: That will go to budget and finance. 11602-20.

MR. BARKER: An ordinance approving the sale of a parcel of property identified as McWinney Street, Borough of Munhall, Pennsylvania Block and Lot 182-A-9, for the sale price of \$1,500 to Gregory Baranowski, an adult individual and Munhall resident sponsored by the chief executive.

PRESIDENT CATENA: That will go to budget. 11603-20.

MR. BARKER: An ordinance of the County of Allegheny, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania authorizing Allegheny County Budo-Kai to use a structure on Brownsville Road in the County's South Park sponsored by the chief executive.

PRESIDENT CATENA: That will go to parks. 11604-20.

MR. BARKER: An ordinance of the County of Allegheny, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania authorizing Mon Valley Express Drum & Bugle Corps, also known as Mon Valley Express, Inc., to use a structure on Brownsville Road in the County's South Park sponsored by the chief executive.

PRESIDENT CATENA: 11605-20.

MR. BARKER: I apologize for 11604, refer to parks as well?

PRESIDENT CATENA: Oh, parks. Sorry.

MR. BARKER: 11605-20. A resolution of the Council of the County of Allegheny authorizing the County to adopt the Rules and Regulations of the Allegheny County Human Relations Commission in order to effect the policies and provisions of Chapter 215 Article V of the Allegheny County Code sponsored by the chief executive and council members Duerr, Klein and Walton.

PRESIDENT CATENA: On that one, I believe Council Member Bennett and Council Member Hallam also want to be added as sponsors. Is that correct for the both of you?

MS. HALLAM: That's correct.

MS. BENNETT: It is.

PRESIDENT CATENA: Is there anyone else that would like to be added as a sponsor? Hearing none, that will go to government reform. Notification of contracts. 11606-20.
