



In April, Allegheny County Council Members attended the Allegheny League of Municipalities (ALOM) 2023 Spring Educational Conference held annually at Seven Springs. This year's conference featured a County Council Panel Discussion allowing Council to provide their specific insights about local government.



ALOM's Marquee event is to provide education and networking opportunities to staff, appointed and elected offices with a stake in municipal government. Each Spring Educational Conference hosts 20+ educational sessions facilitated by knowledgeable experts. Over the last 5 years, the event has grown over 30%, and in 2023 welcomed over 425 local government elected and appointed officials in addition to 75 exhibitors and a host of speakers, educators and dignitaries.

## Legislative Updates

### Ordinances:

**Bill No. 12607-23** - enacted on May 23, 2023.  
An Ordinance of the County of Allegheny, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, repealing all existing provisions of the Allegheny County Code of Ordinances, Chapter 220, entitled "Campaign Finance Reports and Statements," replacing them with new provisions in order to establish updated campaign finance regulations for all candidates for County elected office, and making related amendments to Article 1013 of the Administrative Code of Allegheny County.

**Bill No. 12608-23** - enacted on May 23, 2023.  
An ordinance of the County of Allegheny, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, amending and supplementing the Allegheny County Code of Ordinances, Chapter 220, entitled "Campaign Finance Regulations," in order to clarify the permissible uses of campaign funds by candidates for County elected office.

**Bill No. 12638-23** - enacted on June 6, 2023. An Ordinance of the County of Allegheny, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, directing that a referendum question regarding the amendment of Article III, §7(a) of the Home Rule Charter of Allegheny County, which establishes a per-meeting stipend pay structure for members of Council, be placed on the November 7, 2023 General Election ballot.

### Motions:

**Bill No. 12681-23** - Motion of the Council of Allegheny County urging the General Assembly to enact, with all deliberate speed, the provisions of S.B. 400, introduced on April 26, 2023, and providing for the institution of a semi-open Primary Election voting process in the Commonwealth.

**Bill No. 12719-23** - Motion of the Council of Allegheny County authorizing a public hearing, pursuant to §801.05 of the Administrative Code on Thursday, June 15, 2023, at 6:00 pm in the Gold Room of the Allegheny County Courthouse.

**Bill No. 12720-23** - Motion of the Council of Allegheny County authorizing the publication of an advertisement seeking participants in the Juvenile Justice Study Group process.

**Bill No. 12728-23** - Motion of the Council of Allegheny County urging the Chief Executive to explore cooperative efforts with the City of Pittsburgh to utilize some portion of the former Veterans Administration (VA) Hospital in Highland Park as a low barrier shelter for unhoused individuals.

**Bill No. 12728-23** - Motion of the Council of Allegheny County urging the General Assembly to consider, and with all deliberate speed enact, provisions allowing for excused absences relating to mental health for Pennsylvania primary and secondary education students.

**Bill No. 12729-23** - Motion of the Council of Allegheny County overriding Chief Executive Rich Fitzgerald's veto of Bill No. 12345-22, entitled "[a]n Ordinance of the County of Allegheny, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, amending and supplementing the Administrative Code of Allegheny County, Article 1009, entitled "Personnel Policies," through the creation of a new §5-1009.09, entitled "Non-salaried Employee Pay," in order to establish a uniform policy governing the payment of County employees."
