

Community Development Block Grant - Child Care FAQs

1. Question: What types of child care applications will be considered?

Answer: There are two types of child care focused projects that will be considered:

- Projects proposed by direct service child care providers
- Projects proposed by child care focused intermediaries

2. Question: Who can apply?

Answer: Child care providers outside of The City of Pittsburgh, The City of McKeesport, the Municipality of Penn Hills, McDonald and Trafford Boroughs, and Sewickley Hills Borough

3. Question: What is the timeline for this application?

Answer: The deadline to submit completed applications is Monday, December 1, 2025.

4. Question: What is the minimum and maximum project request?

Answer: The minimum funding request is \$50,000. Initial grants are limited to a maximum of \$75,000.

5. Question: What types of child care projects have been funded in the past?

Answer: Child care facility renovations to improve HVAC systems, accessibility, and address needed repairs.

6. Question: What types of child care projects could be considered?

Answer: Facility improvements to address needed renovations or to serve more children and families, including ADA improvements/upgrades

7. Question: What types of child care projects would not be considered?

Answer: Operational costs to cover current programming needs, such as diapers, wipes, and food.

8. Question: Can I request funds to renovate or make improvements to a building my program rents space in?

Answer: No. All proposed renovations or projects must be for buildings owned by the organization that is proposing them.

9. Question: What types of projects can child care intermediaries apply for?

Answer: Intermediaries may propose projects like supporting child care programs in developing their business practices or providing technical assistance.
