These comments request action by the Board of Elections to solve a known problem in the Oak Hill section of Pittsburgh where four district polling places have been compelled to vote in one cramped space.

There was a period of time when voters who resided in Oak Hill, were assigned to three different polling places. For at least the past three elections, however, voters who reside in four distinct districts in the 4th and 5th Wards, whose voters are predominantly African American, must vote in a one-room space in the Rental Office at Oak Hill. The space for the four polling places is so small that it does not allow adequate social distancing, and feels unsafe in the era of the COVID-19 and Delta variant pandemic. In addition, the space is so small that it creates chaos and confusion for voters seeking to find their respective polling places.

Many of the residents of Oak Hill are old or disabled or both. Requiring some of the most vulnerable residents to walk down a hill to the Rental Office and then uphill to return to their homes aggravates the burden placed on them by their having to vote in one consolidated and inadequate space.

As representatives of citizens who vote in the Oak Hill Rental Office, we urge the Board of Elections to rectify the problems caused to voters from four distinct districts being required to vote in one cramped space without appropriate social distancing.
