In accordance with the general provisions of the Pennsylvania Election code, notice is hereby given to the electors of the 42nd Legislative District that a Special Election will be held in said district on Tuesday, February 24, 2026. The vacancy to be filled is for the unexpired term of the Honorable Dan Miller. This Special Election will be held between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. prevailing time at the election districts herein.

The 42nd Legislative District is composed of the following municipalities: Baldwin Township, Castle Shannon, Dormont, Mt. Lebanon, and Upper St. Clair, Wards 1 and 2, Ward 3 District 3, and Ward 4 District 1.

In this Special Election, all registered voters regardless of political party affiliation are entitled to vote.
