

HOW TO SHOP AT A FARMERS MARKET:

1. Arrive at the market when it first opens for the best selection.
2. If you are using your EBT, P-EBT, credit or debit card, go to the Fresh Access tent first to buy tokens.
3. When using cash, farmers appreciate small bills and change.
4. Ask farmers questions! They like to share recipes, cooking, and storage tips.
5. Don't ask farmers to change the price.
6. You can always ask for help at the Fresh Access tent.

HOW TO USE YOUR FOOD STAMP (EBT), P-EBT, CREDIT OR DEBIT CARD TO SHOP AT THE FARMERS MARKET:



1. Go to the Just Harvest tent and look for the staff member in charge.

2. Use your card to purchase as many \$0.50 or \$1 tokens as you like. These tokens will act as cash at the market.

3. Use your tokens at any farm stand that displays a sign stating "EBT/Credit/Debit Tokens Accepted Here!"

For every \$5 you spend in food stamps get an extra \$2 to spend on fruits & veggies!

WHAT YOU CAN BUY WITH YOUR FOOD STAMP TOKENS:

- Fruits and vegetables
- Bread
- Meat, fish, poultry
- Dairy products
- Maple and honey products
- Seeds and plants that produce food
- Baked goods that are wrapped and intended for home consumption
- Jams, pickles, sauces and other prepared foods



WHAT TO DO WITH LEFTOVER TOKENS:



- You can keep tokens and use them next time you shop at any Fresh Access market. They are good all season!
- Unused tokens can also be returned at the Fresh Access tent and refunded onto your SNAP EBT card.
