**MEMORANDUM**

December 10, 2021

**To: Asbestos Abatement Contractors**  
**Subject: ACHD Rules and Regulations, Article XXI**

This memorandum serves to highlight regulations that are regularly overlooked by contractors. Please initial the column on the right to show you have read and understand each regulation listed below. Failure to follow these regulations may result in violations and penalties.

Regulation	Description	Initials
2105.62.f.1 2105.62.h.3	A <b>properly completed</b> asbestos abatement permit application or notification for undersized projects and demolitions shall be submitted 10 days prior to the proposed start date of the project. Incomplete permit applications or notifications will be returned. The 10-day waiting period begins when the required information and documentation is complete.	
2105.62.g.6	A copy of the documentation of the results of the ACM inspection showing that no asbestos removal project permit is required due to the presence of less than 160 square feet of ACM in the proposed project area.	
2105.62.h.3.i	Documentation of the results of the ACM inspection is required for projects where 160 square feet or more of ACM is to be removed from the proposed project area.	
2105.62.h.7.A	A permit shall expire on either the project completion date identified on the permit application, any expiration date identified on the issued permit, or 365 days after the date of issuance, whichever is sooner.	
2105.62.h.8	Permit amendment applications shall be submitted in writing and be approved by the Department prior to starting work.	
2105.62.k	The Department shall be notified upon the completion of the set-up and preparation of the work area. <b>Contractors shall not start the abatement work before contacting the department.</b>	
2105.63.k	The project work area shall not be opened to the public prior to receiving final clearance from the Department.	
2105.63.l	All waste manifests and other documentation of transportation and disposal of the asbestos-containing waste materials shall be made available to the Department upon request.	

Note: ACHD will accept signed permit applications and notifications via email or regular mail. The 10-day waiting period starts with the postmarked date or hand delivery date of the permit fee payment. The 10-day waiting period for notifications begin on the postmarked or email date.
