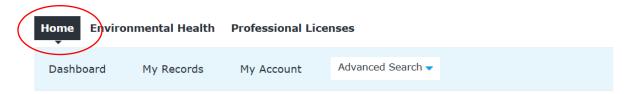

Adding an existing Company/Professional License to your Accela Dashboard Account/Collection

- 1. Login to Accela using your credentials. If you are having issues with your account, please email achdasbestos@alleghenycounty.us.
- 2. Start at your **Home** Page. The **Home** Page is your "Front Page" containing a view of your Dashboard, Collections, and Records in addition to other options. Click on the "Home" tab

3. Fine the "My Records" tab and click there



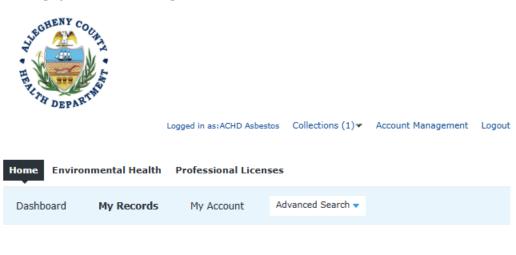

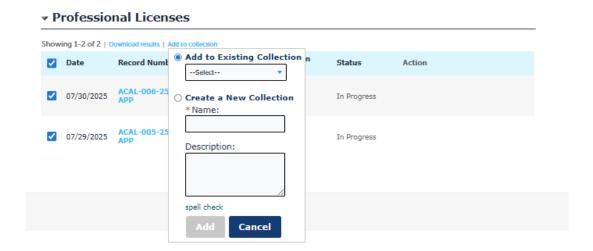

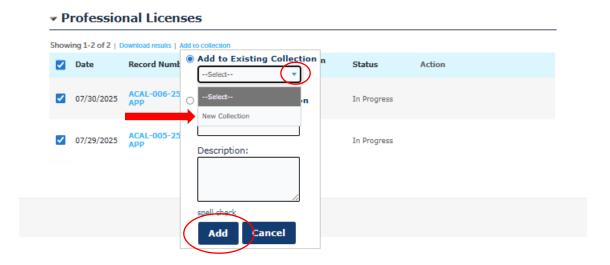




8. From the drop-down menu you can choose to add the license records to an existing collection on your account, or you have the option to create a new collection to add the license to



9. If you are adding the license to an existing collection select the small blue arrow and choose the collection to add to and then select the "Add" tab





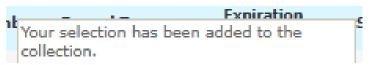




10. If you are creating a new collection, select that option, add a name to the new collection and then select the "Add" tab. Adding a description to a new collection is not a required field (it is optional)
