Submitting an Asbestos Permit Application

- 1. Login to Accela using your credentials. If you are having issues with your account, please email achdasbestos@alleghenycounty.us.
- 2. Start at your **Home** Page. The **Home** Page is your "Front Page" containing a view of your Dashboard, Collections, and Records in addition to other options.



3. Click **My Records** on your **Home** Page.



4. Click on the record number applicable to review the application.



5. Review the record to the best of your ability. You will need to expand the application by clicking on the **More Details** triangle.









6. You will have to expand the application again by clicking the + symbol next to each section.



- 7. You may complete the owner attestation 2 ways.
 - a. You may click Create Amendment from the review page.




b. You may click Amendment from My Records page.









10. Review your submission then click Continue Application.
