RE: Notice of Violation #ASB-21-1202 – Violations of Article XXI ("Air Pollution Control") at property 5401 Penn Ave., Pittsburgh, PA 15206.

Dear Mr. Fisher,

On March 18, 2021 an ACHD Representative stopped at 5401 Penn Ave. to request an asbestos survey from an active renovation project. The interior of the building was empty and debris was being transferred into a dumpster outside of the building. After speaking with the supervisor on site as well as the owner of the property, it was determined that an asbestos survey was not completed prior to the renovation project at 5401 Penn Ave. A stop work order was issued on March 18th for work to cease until TEM air sampling for airborne asbestos could be completed on site as well as any further bulk sampling of leftover materials.

The TEM air sample results concluded that asbestos fibers were not present in the air at the time of sampling within the facility. Bulk sampling on the premises did not yield any positive samples at the time of sampling.

Please allow this correspondence serve as notice to Mr. Kevin Fisher of the following violations of the Allegheny County Health Department Rules and Regulations, Article XXI ("Air Pollution Control"):





a. **Article XXI § 2105.62.b:** Failure to perform an asbestos survey prior to demolition or renovation.

Please be advised that the ACHD has calculated a civil penalty in the amount of \$1,375.00 for the above violation. Before issuing a final order and civil penalty, the ACHD requests an opportunity to meet. Please contact the ACHD within **14 days** of receipt of this notice to schedule a meeting to discuss the violation. A meeting may be scheduled by contacting Shannon Sandberg via email at ACHDAsbestos@AlleghenyCounty.US If a meeting is not requested, the ACHD will proceed with further enforcement action.

This Notice of Violation is neither an order nor any other final action of the Allegheny County Health Department. It neither imposes nor waives any enforcement action available to the Department under any of its statutes. If the ACHD determines that an enforcement action is appropriate, you will be notified of the action. Please be aware that any violation of the Article XXI regulations subjects a person to a variety of enforcement actions, including a civil penalty of up to \$25,000 per violation per day.
