Dear Mr. Jackson:

After a review of the Fluidized Bed Incinerator 2 (FBI-2) Emission Testing report received on August 24, 2021, the Allegheny County Health Department (ACHD) has determined the Allegheny County Sanitary Authority (ALCOSAN) exceeded the federal limits for lead and cadmium. 40 CFR § Part 62 Subpart LLL - Federal Plan Requirements for Sewage Sludge Incineration Units Constructed on or Before October 14, 2010 – lists the compliance limits in Table 2. The test results for the June 22-24, 2021 compliance test and the emission limit for these pollutants detailed in 40CFR 62, subpart LLL are shown below.

The ACHD has determined that ALCOSAN is in violation of Federal Plan Requirements for Sewage Sludge Incineration Units by exceeding the compliance limit for lead and cadmium shown in Table 2 of the beforementioned subpart.

This Notice of Violation is neither an order nor any other final action of the Allegheny County Health Department. It neither imposes nor waives any enforcement action

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available to the Department under any of its statutes. If the Department determines that an enforcement action is appropriate, you will be notified of the action. Please be aware that any violation of the Article XXI regulations subjects a person to a variety of enforcement actions, including a civil penalty of up to \$25,000 per violation per day.

The Allegheny County Health Department is currently reviewing this violation to determine whether corrective actions are required and if a civil penalty is appropriate.
