Coraopolis Terminals reported several deviations from the terms and conditions of Operating Permit 0041. The roof landing deviations (Conditions V.B.1.c and V.C.1.c) were stated as having previously been included in the quarterly reports. However, a review of the quarterly reports submitted under the Operating Permit as well as those submitted for the MACT (40 CFR Part 63 Subpart BBBBBB) did not find any reference to these deviations. The General and Site Level deviations (III.1, III.3, III.21, and IV.26.a) apply to the roof landing deviations also.
