RE: Notice of Violation #210601 - Violations of Installation Permit 0297-I003 Conditions V.A.5.a.2) and V.A.5.a.3) and Article XXI (“Air Pollution Control”), §2103.12.k.1; at property 214 Westbridge Drive, Morgan, PA 15064.

Dear Mr. McQuillen:

The Semiannual Report submitted by Servsteel on August 13, 2020 was deficient in that the following data were not included:

- a. Minimum thermal oxidizer temperatures
- b. Pitch consumption amounts
- c. Finished production amounts
- d. Process air flow -- a single value was reported which was the stack exhaust from the aborted March 24, 2020 test. The actual inlet flow must be monitored, recorded, and reported.

The Semiannual Report submitted by Servsteel on February 5, 2021 was missing the same items as the August 2020 report, except that no value was reported for process air flow. The Department met with Servsteel to discuss the alleged violation and corrective action. It was

agreed that Servsteel will submit the required information in semiannual reports broken out by month.

This Notice of Violation is neither an order nor any other final action of the Allegheny County Health Department. It neither imposes nor waives any enforcement action available to the Department under any of its statutes. If the Department determines that an enforcement action is appropriate, you will be notified of the action. Please be aware that any violation of the Article XXI regulations subjects a person to a variety of enforcement actions, including a civil penalty of up to \$25,000 per violation per day.

The Allegheny County Health Department is currently reviewing this violation to determine whether corrective actions are required and if a civil penalty is appropriate.
