Note:

- Air Quality. The Board has no codified responsibility for establishment or oversight of the Air Quality Advisory Committee. The Committee may advise the Department and the Board on matters relative to air quality which are brought to its attention by any person.
- Housing. The Board has no codified responsibility for establishment or oversight of the Housing Advisory Committee. The Committee may advise the Department and the Board on matters relative to housing which are brought to its attention by any person.
- Food Safety. The members of the Food Safety Advisory Committee are appointed by Director to a term of 3 years (plus 2 years following an expired term if approved by Board) as defined in Section 350, Article III. The Committee will advise the Department and the Board on matters relative to food safety which are brought to its attention by any person.
- Plumbing. Members of the Plumbing Advisory Board shall be appointed according to AC-110.1 General and AC-110.2 Terms of Appointments. The Board of Health “may direct the Plumbing Advisory Board to review and comment upon rules, regulations, standards, policies, and procedures proposed by the Department” according to AC-104.2 Rule-making authority.
