

ALLEGHENY COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT
ADMINISTRATIVE HEARING

In Re: The Islay Company, 537 East Ohio Street, Pittsburgh, PA 15212

AND NOW, this 8th day of January, 2018, it is hereby ORDERED that the Allegheny County Health Department's ("ACHD") motion to dismiss the appeal under Article XI § 1104(B) of the ACHD's Rules & Regulations, is **GRANTED**, for the following reasons:

- 1) Appellant The Islay Company ("Appellant") has failed to "set forth with particularity the manner in which the Appellant is aggrieved by the Action of the Department, the extent to which the Appellant has a direct interest in the action and the grounds for his or her appeal." Art. XI § 1104(B).
- 2) The appeal only contains the conclusory statement: "I Malik M. Safdar would like to appeal this decision." There are no grounds for the appeal listed, nor is there any explanation of the manner in which Appellant was aggrieved.
- 3) Therefore, Appellant's appeal is hereby **DISMISSED**.
