

ALLEGHENY COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT
ADMINISTRATIVE DECISION

In Re: The Islay Company, 537 East Ohio Street, Pittsburgh, PA 15212

AND NOW, this 16th day of March, 2018, it is hereby ORDERED that the Allegheny County Health Department's ("ACHD") motion to dismiss the appeal dated January 19, 2018 under Article XI § 1104(B) of the ACHD's Rules & Regulations, is **GRANTED**, for the following reasons:

- 1) Appellant The Islay Company ("Appellant") has failed to "set forth with particularity the manner in which the Appellant is aggrieved by the Action of the Department, the extent to which the Appellant has a direct interest in the action and the grounds for his or her appeal." Art. XI § 1104(B).
- 2) The appeal only contains the conclusory statement: "I Malik M. Safdar would like to appeal this decision." There are no grounds for the appeal listed, nor is there any explanation of the manner in which Appellant was aggrieved.
- 3) In its January 19, 2018 appeal, Appellant failed to make any argument whatsoever as to the grounds for its appeal or the manner in which it was aggrieved. Appellant's January 19, 2018 appeal was functionally identical to its December 15, 2017 appeal.
- 4) Therefore, Appellant's appeal is hereby **DISMISSED**.
