RE: Lillen's Restaurant Appeal (Client # 57868).

Dear Mr. Slater:

On December 5, 2017, the Allegheny County Health Department ("ACHD") issued an inspection report which documented alleged violations of ACHD Rules and Regulations Article III, Food Safety ("Article III"), committed at Lillen's Restaurant, 535 E. Ohio Street, Pittsburgh, PA 15212 ("Lillen's Restaurant"). The ACHD observed violations including foods not labeled with a discard date, no certified manager, and customer seats available but no customer restrooms provided. On December 13, 2017, Mohammad Munir appealed and requested a hearing for the violation of not having a public restroom and requested a variance to provide seats without having to install public restrooms.

On May 18, 2018, the ACHD granted Mr. Munir's variance request and determined that Lillen's Restaurant was grandfathered in, pursuant to Article III § 316.1(C), and thus, it is allowed to provide customer seating without installing public restrooms. Therefore, Mr. Munir's appeal is moot and must be dismissed. If you have any questions, I can be reached at 412-578-2653.

Such facilities already in existence prior to the aforementioned date are exempt from public toilet room requirements stated in Section 316.1C of the Allegheny County Health Department's "Article III," rules and regulations governing "Food Safety."

Be advised, should this facility undergo remodeling, construction, expansion or change in nature of business, it will no longer be exempt from toilet room requirements.
