

Dear Hearing Officer Slater:

On March 6, 2018, the Allegheny County Health Department ("Department") received an appeal from Polish on Penn, dba S&D Polish Deli, 2204 Penn Ave., Pittsburgh, PA 15222 ("Facility"). The appeal vaguely states that the Facility appeals the findings of the inspection report dated February 9, 2018 ("Feb. 9<sup>th</sup> inspection report"). The Department found the appeal to be insufficient as provided by the Department's Rules and Regulations Article XI, Hearings and Appeals ("Article XI"). Therefore, the Department contacted the appellant on April 18, 2018 and requested that the appellant amend its appeal to include additional information such as whether the appellant is appealing specific orders in the Feb. 9<sup>th</sup> inspection report or the entire report. The appellant replied and said it would provide the requested information promptly.

The Department hereby files a motion to dismiss the appeal on the following grounds. First, the appeal does not set forth with particularity the manner in which the appellant is aggrieved by the action of the Department. Article XI § 1104.B. The Department should not speculate as to which portions of the Feb. 9<sup>th</sup> inspection report the appellant is aggrieved by. Moreover, the time to amend the appeal ended on April 6, 2018. Article XI § 1104.E. Additional time for amending the appeal to make it sufficient under Article XI §1104 should not be granted because the appellant never responded in a timely manner to the Department's April 18<sup>th</sup> request, which was nearly three months ago. Even if this tribunal believes the time to amend the appeal began when the Department's request was made, the period to amend would have ended May 18, 2018. Therefore, the Department requests that the appeal be dismissed. If you have any questions, I can be reached at 412-578-2653.
