Public Health Clinic Information

The Allegheny County Health Department Public Health Clinic provides free STI/HIV testing and treatment. We offer services via both walk-ins and appointments.

To schedule an appointment call 412-578-8081.

- Walk-in patients are seen on a first come, first served basis.
- No insurance is necessary.
- Anyone 13 years and older can be seen at the clinic without parental consent.
- Patients seen regardless of immigration status.

Patients are asked to bring photo ID (i.e. driver's license, passport, college ID) when being seen. Patients can be seen without a photo ID, though a photo ID is required to receive results.

Language line services are available for a variety of languages. An on-site interpreter can be scheduled with advance notice.

If you are having symptoms additional testing may be offered. Patients diagnosed with HIV will receive referrals for medical care.

Public Health Clinic Services:

Testing and Treatment

- HIV testing (blood)
- Syphilis (blood)
- Chlamydia
- Gonorrhea
- Mpox virus
- Trichomoniasis (vaginal screening only)
- Hepatitis C
- Hepatitis B (titers to check immunity and requires a fee per lab: \$25 Residents | \$30 Non-Residents)
- Herpes (we do not provide a blood test, but will conduct a culture if lesions are present)
- Genital Warts (treatment only)

Vaccines

- Hepatitis A vaccine
- Hepatitis B vaccine
- Human Papillomavirus (HPV) vaccine
- Mpox (JYNNEOS) vaccine

Other Clinical Services

- Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP) and Post-Exposure Prophylaxis (PEP) for HIV prevention
- Cervical Cancer Screening (Pap Smear and HPV Test)
- Emergency oral contraception: ella® (ulipristal acetate) or Plan B® (levonorgestrel).
- Expedited Partner Therapy (EPT)
- DoxyPEP for bacterial infections



The Public Health Clinic DOES NOT Provide Tests For the Following:

- Urinary Tract infection (UTI)
- Pregnancy
- Physical Exams
- Rapid HIV tests

Partner Services

Allegheny County Health Department staff may contact sexual partners to encourage them to come in for free HIV/STI testing and treatment. This is a voluntary service for anyone diagnosed with a reportable STI. Staff members do not reveal any identifying information about the patient while informing their partners about a potential exposure. Partner notification works to reduce the spread of HIV/STIs in Allegheny County.
