## **GONORRHEA**



2,395 cases of gonorrhea 6% increase from 2020



59% of cases in males Highest among 20-34-year-olds

### **CHLAMYDIA**



5,713 cases of chlamydia 1% decrease from 2020



40% of infections in females 15-24 years

## **SYPHILIS**



328 cases of early syphilis 12% increase from 2020



Males accounted for 90% of early syphilis cases



63% of early syphilis cases in persons 20-34 years

**STDs increased by** 1.4% from 2020 to 2021 and reached the highest point in 9 years

- Individuals at risk for STDs should be screened for syphilis, chlamydia, gonorrhea, and HIV
- Sexually active women <25 years should get tested for gonorrhea and chlamydia annually
- Gay, bisexual, and men who have sex with men should be tested for all STDs annually
- Everyone between 13-64 years should get an HIV test at least once as part of routine care or more frequently if at high risk of STDs
- Pregnant persons should get syphilis screenings at 1<sup>st</sup> visit, 3<sup>rd</sup> trimester, and delivery
