- **I. Call to Order**: Chair Bigley called the meeting to order.
- **II.** \*Action: Mr. Cummins motioned to approve the minutes from the Advisory Board's meeting on October 17, 2024. Mr. Claus seconded the motion.
  - The motion carried by a vote of 6 in favor with 0 against. (Mr. Green joined the meeting remotely after this vote was already cast)
- **III. Program Update**: Mr. Grese thanked the attendees for coming and provided updated end of year statistics about the program. Mr. Rabinowitz stated that the program may be moving to new office locations at the end of 2025 or beginning of 2026. He also stated that Accela may be launched in June 2025.
- IV. Upcoming April Journeyman/Masters Exam: Mr. Grese stated that the next exams will be held at the Elizabeth Fire Hall on April 24<sup>th</sup> for all Masters candidates and Mon-Yough apprentices, and on April 25<sup>th</sup> for all AMPAC and Local 27 apprentices. This will be the first exam to incorporate questions about the 2022 code changes.
