

Get Vaccinated for **HEPATITIS B** Protect Yourself!

WHO SHOULD GET A HEPATITIS B VACCINE?

- Adults aged 19 – 59 years or 60 and older with risk factors
- People with more than one partner during the previous 6 months
- People seeking evaluation or treatment for a sexually transmitted infection
- Men who have sex with men
- People who use or inject drugs

DID YOU KNOW? HEPATITIS B IS:

- A highly contagious liver infection caused by a virus.
- Transmissible through blood, semen, and other bodily fluids from an infected person. For example:
 - Sexual contact
 - Sharing needles, syringes, or other drug injection equipment
 - During pregnancy or delivery
- Vaccine preventable!

The Allegheny County Health Department's Public Health Clinic is now offering vaccines for Hepatitis A, Hepatitis B, Human Papillomavirus (HPV), and Mpox (JYNNEOS) for eligible individuals.

Please bring your insurance card. Vaccines are free to individuals who are uninsured.
