## Allegheny County Health Department Housing and Community Environment Program response to elevated blood lead tests

In PA, all blood lead test results on both venous and capillary specimens for persons under 16 years of age must be reported into PA-NEDSS (Pennsylvania's version of the National Electronic Disease Surveillance System) (PA Code, Title 28, Chapter 27). Reporting lead test results into PA-NEDSS is the best way to ensure your patients receive follow up services.
