Safer Substance Use During COVID-19

Tips to Prevent Overdose and Infections

Avoid sharing supplies and prepare your own substances Practice good hygiene measures

- If sharing can't be avoided, clean equipment
- Wash your hands with soap and clean water for 20 seconds or use hand sanitizer
- Keep your surface clean. Use disinfectant wipes/diluted bleach to wipe it down

Don't use alone. Wear a face covering & keep 6 feet distance

Use small amounts of a drug at a time

Check street drugs with fentanyl test strips (available at Prevention Point)

Have Naloxone (Narcan) available to reverse an opioid overdose
