The Pennsylvania Justice Network Pre-Log system is still offline. During this outage, the Allegheny County Office of the Medical Examiner Forensic Laboratory Division continues to accept manual evidence submissions. In place of the prelog submission form, each Law Enforcement Agency must fully complete the appropriate submission request form(s) for each case and bring those with the evidence at the time of submission. The ACOME Evidence Receiving team must manually transfer all of the information into the ACOME Laboratory Information Management System.

This will cause the evidence intake process to be more time consuming. We ask for your patience during the submission process. If your agency has a large volume of evidence to submit, please contact the Evidence Receiving team to schedule a time for evidence submission. This will help reduce the wait time for evidence submission.

ACOME does not have control over the timeline to reinstate the use of the Pre-log process. We thank you in advance for your patience and understanding.
