

ALLEGHENY COUNTY OFFICE OF PROPERTY ASSESSMENTS CATASTROPHIC LOSS APPLICATION 72 P.S. 5452.10

This application is intended for property owners who have suffered a catastrophic loss to their property. Under Pennsylvania law, catastrophic loss is any damage to a structure due to a fire or other natural disaster that results in diminishing a person's real property value by 50% or more. In order to qualify for a reduction in property assessment, this application must be filed by the property owner within six (6) months from the date that the catastrophic loss occurred, or before the end of the calendar year, whichever is longer.

PLEASE NOTE: Personal property loss is not included, such as appliances, flooring, or furniture.
