

ALLEGHENY COUNTY OFFICE OF PROPERTY ASSESSMENTS CATASTROPHIC LOSS FORM 72 P.S. 5452.10

This form is intended for those persons who have suffered a catastrophic loss to their property. Under Pennsylvania law, catastrophic loss is any damage to a structure due to a fire or other natural disaster that results in diminishing a person's real property value by 50% or more. In order to qualify for a reduction in your property assessment, you should file this application within six (6) months from the date that the catastrophic loss occurred, or within the remainder of the calendar year, whichever is longer. Personal property loss is not included, such as appliances, flooring, or furniture.
