

Two of my cases are scheduled for the same time at two different places. What do I do?



Call the office.
We will get one of your court dates rescheduled.

What do I do if there is a warrant out for my arrest?



Call us.
We will work with
you and the courts
to clear the warrant.

I'm in the hospital and I can't make it to my court hearing. Will I get in trouble?



You have to ask the facility to fax a letter to the court saying that you are there.

PRELIMINARY HEARING

ARRIVE AT THE MAGISTERIAL DISTRICT COURT AT LEAST 30 MINUTES EARLY

Arriving late can lead to a warrant.

WEAR PROFESSIONAL CLOTHES

No t-shirts, shorts, flip-flops, or sweatshirts

LET YOUR ATTORNEY DO THE TALKING

Don't talk to the Judge, police officers or any witnesses or alleged victims

YOU WILL NOT BE TESTIFYING!

YOU DO NOT NEED TO BRING ANY WITNESSES!
