# 1. Tupelo/Summit

Stone and log construction shelter with view of Wildwood valley.

 Along South Ridge Drive. Access down old road north of recycling center in parking lot behind pool.

### 2. Fountain of Youth

Spring House design as a grotto.

 Park on east side of Kummer Road. Access is only possible by going down the steep hillside and across the stream, approximately 100' from where vehicles can be parked.

## 3. Oakdene

Oven shelter on the site of an old quarry.

 Overlooks Irwin Pond. Access from Red with Black Dot Trail off Pearce Mill Road.

# 4. Ledgewood

Open oven shelter using native boulders.

 Intersection of Ingomar and Kummer Roads. Park by Ledgewood shelter and enter the Purple Trail. Ledgewood is 300' from the trail head.


