We do not have a facility but help people in need find housing both temporary and permanent. Would we be considered for an opportunity to become a Program Proposer?**

Yes, any non-profit that can meet the contract requirements and can that deliver the services as described in the RFP is eligible to be a Proposer this RFP. A facility is not required. If your Proposal is successful, you would be required to use our HMIS and Coordinated Entry systems and any clients served would be referred from the Allegheny Link. This would cause your client-base to expand and any family, friends or associates would need to be referred through the Allegheny Link to be served.
