Free education series for family caregivers offered at sites around Allegheny County

The Area Agency on Aging (AAA) is offering a free six-week education series, <u>Powerful Tools for Caregivers</u>, at senior centers around Allegheny County to educate nonprofessional caregivers about self-care.

Topics discussed through the series include caregiver self-care; identifying and reducing personal stress; communicating feelings, needs, and concerns; communicating in challenging situations; learning from our emotions; and mastering caregiving decisions. Participants must be present for all six sessions.
