Community Resource Navigators are available to assist human services agencies funded by DHS and other community partners in connecting clients to the resources and help that they need.

Community Resource Navigators can:

- Provide technical assistance when partners have exhausted options to meet a client's needs, and aren't sure what to do next
- Make connections between multiple service providers so that they can work as a team
- Offer short term case management to individuals and families who are not yet working with someone who can help
- Draw on DHS expertise to ensure warm handoffs to trusted services and resources
