
Changes to the Contracted Providers section of the DHS website

With that in mind, the <u>Doing Business</u> (formerly Contracted Providers) section of the DHS website has been completely redesigned to be more user-friendly.


- You can quickly get to the Doing Business section by clicking on the Doing Business link in the gold bar that runs across the homepage. Image

Doing Business Section Hints



Here are a few hints to help you get acquainted with the new grouping of provider information.

- 1. The new <u>CURRENT DHS-CONTRACTED</u> <u>PROVIDERS</u> page includes any information that is related to EVERY contracted provider regardless of their source of funding.
- 2. At the bottom, and in the sub-navigation bar on the right of the CURRENT DHS-CONTRACTED PROVIDERS page, there are links to office-specific pages that have all the information needed by a DHS contractor who is funded by that office.



- A new page, <u>COMMUNIQUES</u>, includes important, timely information for all providers. It should be checked routinely. Posts on this page will only last two weeks or until the event expires.
 - Some DHS offices may have officespecific communiques page. In those cases, those pages should also be checked routinely for new information.
