**Intensive Outpatient Program (IOP):** IOP involves 5-10 hours of clinical programming per week, in 2-3 days, usually in a group format, for a length of stay of 3-6 weeks. IOP combines both psychoeducational recovery groups and therapy groups in which clients determine specific problems and issues to discuss. Individual and/or family sessions may be provided.

**Partial Hospital Programming (PH):** PH involves 10 or more hours of programming per week on at least 3 days each week. Although group is the main modality used, licensing regulations require that each PH client receive two individual sessions per week.
