

Psychiatric Rehabilitation (Half-Day Workshop)

Psychiatric rehabilitative services are client-centered, strength-based services designed to promote self-determination, skill development, and connection to resources that assist in the success of living independently. In this training, participants will discover the importance of identifying an individual's learning style and how different learning styles translate to teaching psychiatric rehabilitative skills. They will also learn the step-by-step processes of assessing both housing and psychiatric rehabilitation skill building needs and developing an individualized plan to support clients' success in the community. The course will conclude with opportunities to practice appropriate documentation ensuring that the treatment plan accurately reflects the systematic approach to providing psychiatric rehabilitative services.
