Comments will not be accepted after this time.

A public hearing will be held regarding the proposed issuance of these permits on **Monday, April 13, 2026, at 6 pm** in the conference room at the ACHD office at 836 Fulton Street, Pittsburgh, PA 15233. Anyone who would like to speak at the hearing should register online **at least 24 hours in advance** of the hearing on the Department's permits webpage at <https://allegHENYcounty.us/AQnotices>. If no one is registered to give testimony at the hearing by Thursday, April 9 the hearing will be canceled. If the hearing is canceled, the Department will provide public notice on the webpage or through the contact information listed above. When making comments on previously issued installation or operating permits being modified, please consider the modified language only.

INTENT TO ISSUE OR MODIFY INSTALLATION PERMITS

EQT PRODUCTION COMPANY – LETO WELL PAD (1027-I001), 301 Oak Road, Gibsonia, PA 15044, for the installation of 1 Tri-ethylene glycol (TEG) dehydration unit, rated at 208 MMSCFD of gas throughput equipped with an associated reboiler rated at 1.5 MMBtu/hr (exempt) and controlled by an enclosed combustor rated at 7.0 MMBtu/hr. Three 400-bbl produced water storage tanks, 1 frac/sand blowdown tank, frac/sand blowdown tank loading, 1 condensate tank, condensate tank truck loading, and 1 gun barrel tank are present at the facility, which vent through a shared header and are controlled by 4 Vapor Destruction Units (VDUs). The installation will result in the following potential increase in emissions: 0.51 tons/yr of PM, 0.51 tons/yr of PM₁₀, 0.16 tons/yr of SO_x, 7.90 tons/yr of NO_x, 18.38 tons/yr of CO, 39.94 tons/yr of VOCs, and 3.56 tons/yr of HAPs.

FAB-TEC INDUSTRIES (1026-I001), 3500 University Boulevard, Coraopolis, PA 15108 for the installation of a steel fabrication facility that operates 1 shot blast booth, 1 paint booth, welding stations, plasma cutting table and fabricating/assembly tools. The installation will result in the following potential increase in emissions: 3.69 tons/yr of PM, 3.69 tons/yr of PM₁₀, 0.03 tons/yr of SO_x, 10.95 tons/yr of NO_x, 4.60 tons/yr of CO, 14.0 tons/yr of VOCs, and 8.53 tons/yr of HAPs.

TAKTL, LLC (1025-I001), 400 Braddock Avenue, Turtle Creek, PA 15145 for the installation of 6 spray booths, 5 storage silos, and 10 natural gas heaters. The installation will result in the following potential increase in emissions: 0.98 tons/yr of PM, 0.98 tons/yr of PM₁₀, 0.02 tons/yr of SO_x, 3.30 tons/yr of NO_x, 2.77 tons/yr of CO, and 10.75 tons/yr of VOCs.

BALLYMORE/TRI-ARC (1014-OP26), 390 Fountain Street, Pittsburgh, PA 15238, for the issuance of a Minor Source Operating Permit for the operation of a ladder and lift assembling facility.

BEINHAUER CREMATORY (0326-OP26), 2630 West Liberty Avenue, Pittsburgh, PA 15216, for the renewal of a Minor Source Operating Permit for a human crematory.

CHAMP PRINTING COMPANY, INC. (0723-OP26), 730 4th Street, Coraopolis, PA 15108 for the renewal of a Minor Source Operating Permit for a commercial printing company consisting of 5 offset lithographic printing presses, 1 digital press, and 1 platemaking department.

LIBERTAS COPPER, DBA HUSSEY COPPER (0153-OP26), 100 Washington Street, Leetsdale, PA 15056 for the issuance of a Minor Source Operating Permit for a flat rolled copper and copper alloy products facility. The operations include furnaces, rolling mills and scalpers, annealing lines, cleaning and degreasing units, two boilers, tanks, and emergency generators.

INSTALLATION PERMITS ISSUED OR MODIFIED

UNITED STATES STEEL CORPORATION – EDGAR THOMSON (0051-I010), 13th Street and Braddock Avenue, Braddock PA 15104, for the installation of a slag granulator system to process molten slag discharge from the blast furnace. The slag granulator will serve as the primary slag processing system, while the existing open slag pit will function as a backup during malfunction or maintenance of the granulator.

MAJOR SOURCE (TITLE V) PERMITS ISSUED OR MODIFIED

PPG INDUSTRIES, INC. – SPRINGDALE PLANT (0057-OP26), 125 Colfax Street, Springdale, PA, for a Title V operating permit. The facility consists of a 20 million gallon per year paint production facility (Paint Plant), a resin development center, and research & development facility (Development Center). The Paint Plant and Development Center are controlled by a thermal oxidizer. Ancillary equipment includes two (2) 25.1 MMBtu natural gas and fuel oil-fired boilers, two (2) 2.5 MMBtu/hr natural gas miscellaneous heaters a 5,000 gallon per year spray paint booth, supplemental spray paint booths, storage tanks, five (5) natural gas emergency generators, two (2) diesel emergency generators, make-up air units and miscellaneous facility ovens. The facility is also subject to National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAPs) 40 CFR Part 63, Subpart HHHHH – Miscellaneous Coating Manufacturing, and Subpart FFFF – Miscellaneous Organic Chemical Manufacturing. PPG Springdale is a major source of volatile organic compounds (VOC) and hazardous air pollutants (HAP); it is a minor source of PM, PM10, PM2.5, NOx, SOx, and CO. The proposed Title V operating permit contains all applicable regulatory requirements including monitoring, recordkeeping, and reporting conditions.
