The DRC offers an additional pair of socks as well as a sweat suit if needed or requested by the reentrant.

Shelters in Allegheny County have typically first come-first served. Reentrants who indicate homelessness while in the office can receive an updated list of shelter vacancies for the day of their release, directions (if desired), and bus pass for transportation to the shelter from ACJ.

The DRC offers additional information on local resources for reentrants to take freely regarding other reentry and social services.
